A Treasure in a Trunk Things Learned From an Autograph Book by Deana Glatz

When going through an old trunk that had belonged to my maternal Grandparents, an old Autograph Book was found that had belonged to my Great Aunt – my Grandfather's Sister, Ella.

Autograph books were traditionally for collecting the autographs of others. They were exchanged among friends, colleagues, and classmates to fill with poems, drawings, personal messages, small pieces of verse and other mementos.

Only seventeen pages were written on, but they contained so much interesting information....



Ella Jane White (January 18, 1880 – November 30, 1955

- This book had been given to Aunt Ella when she was not quite nine years old by her mother, Mary Ellen, for Christmas December 25, 1888 in Santa Rosa so there is a sample of Mary Ellen's handwriting and the date and location of the family.
- Aunt Ella had written on two of the pages samples of her young handwriting.
- Various pages give dates ranging from December 1888 through February 21, 1889 and Santa Rosa as the location of the family.
- Ella carried this book with her when the family relocated to the Diamondville area of Butte Creek Canyon; the next dated entry is March 31, 1891 by her teacher at the 1st Diamondville School, Minnie Nesbit.
- One of Ella's schoolmates, Emma Winders, also signed her book. Although undated, a photo of the 1st Diamondville School in Sept of

1889, the year before Ella came to Butte Creek Canyon, shows Emma as a student. Emma

Winders was the daughter of Thankful Carson, the only survivor of three children captured by Indians in 1863.

 Two other pages, one undated, signed by John Akin and one signed by Annie May or Mary Heppe, Diamondville, July 7, 1891, may also be by schoolmates.





• Another page is signed by Etta Phillips, who was likely Ella's teacher at the 1st Diamondville School in 1892-93 when Ella was 13.

From family history, my Grandfather said that the family had left Santa Rosa and came to the Diamondville area of Butte Creek Canyon during

March of 1890, but it is always nice to have confirmation! So, don't overlook an Autograph Book!
